ADMISSION NOTIFICATION OF Menpa Kachupa (BSRMS -Bachelor of Sowa-Rigpa Medicine & Surgery) FOR THE ACADEMIC SESSION 2019-2020 as approved under F.no. Q-13012/02/2019-EP (1) and under Section 13C/13A of the IMCC Act

This is to notify that the entrance examination for admission in Menpa Kachupa (BSRMS) for the academic session 2019-2020 is scheduled on 4th October, 2019 in the Institute which will be followed by counselling.

Total seats available: 15 (Fifteen)

Eligibility conditions for the admission in above course: -

Candidate seeking admission in the BSRMS 1st year (2019-2020) in **Central Institute of Higher Tibetan Studies, Sarnath, Varanasi** should possess the academic qualification of U.M. II of the faculty of Sowa-Rigpa & Bhot-Jyotish or 12th passed with PCB, PCMB with knowledge of Tibetan language plus having strong enthusiasm to learning Sowa-Rigpa (Tibetan Medicine).

Guidelines of Admission in BSRMS 1st year

- Only those candidates will be eligible for admission test in BSRMS 1st year who have obtained at least 50% marks in aggregate in Sowa Rigpa and Bhot-Jyotish in Uttar Madhyama/12th standard (PCB/PCBM)
- The eligible candidates will have to appear in an entrance examination. The Entrance examination will consist of one Written question papers; Tibetan Grammar and Literature.
- The paper will be of 100 marks with duration of 3 hours followed by **counselling** in the afternoon. The paper will have section 1 with 70 marks (on Tibetan grammar & Literature) and section 2 with 30 marks (General knowledge or Sowa-Rigpa basics).
- The candidates shall have to obtain 50% marks in written test to pass the entrance examination.
- Reservation in admission shall be applicable as per Govt. of India norms. In case of non-availability of candidates in reservation category, the seat will be allotted to general candidates on merit base.
- There is no provision of re-examination and the selection for admission in BSRMS will be strictly on merit basis. The merit list will be defined based on the score obtained in the entrance examination.
- Any student who has poor moral/character record in their past/present school/institute will be barred from admission into Kachupa Program.
- The final confirmation notice naming the admitted candidates will be circulated after the orientation talk by the Hon'ble V.C. or his representative.

The prescribed admission form duly filled up and accompanied with self-attested photocopies of all the relevant documents e.g. Marksheet, fitness, reservation certificate and Caste Certificate etc. may be addressed directly/electronically to: -
