

ADMISSION RULES

ENTRANCE EXAMINATION RULES FOR ADMISSION IN FIRST YEAR OF BACHELOR OF TIBETAN MEDICINE AND SCIENCE (BTMS) OF FACULTY OF CHIKITSA VIDYA

- Candidates seeking admission in the BTMS (Tibetan Chikitsa Vidya) Ist year in this Institute should possess the academic qualification of UM II of the Faculty of Chikitsa Vidya.
- The eligible candidates will have to appear in an entrance examination. The entrance examination will consist of 3 written question papers: 1. Tibetan Grammer and Literature. 2. Basic knowledge of Tibetan Chikitsa Vidya. 3. History of Tibetan Chikitsa Vidya. Each paper will be marked out of 100 marks and will be of 3 hours duration, in accordance with the syllabus.
- A candidate who has obtained at least 50% marks in aggregate in Chikitsa Vidya and Jyotish in Uttar Madhyama will be eligible to appear in entrance examination in BTMS.
- The admission will be on merit basis based on the marks obtained in entrance examination in the subject of History of Chikitsa Vidya and General Knowledge of Chikitsa Vidya. The qualifying marks for admission will be 50% and in Tibetan language candidate will have to obtain 35% marks to qualify for admission. However, the marks obtained in Tibetan Language will not be included in the merit of the candidate.
- The students, who have registered their names in the Tibetan Chikitsa Vidya subject from Purva Madhyama Ist year will be given priority if there are students from Jyotish line desirous to join the Chikitsa Vidya.
- Re-exam will not be allowed.
- The total intake of student (including non-scholarship candidates) may not exceed 7 in number in any given year.
- The final confirmation notice, naming the admitted candidates, will be circulated after the orientation talk by the Hon'ble Director or his representative from the office.
